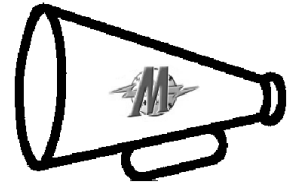

WEATHER REPORT

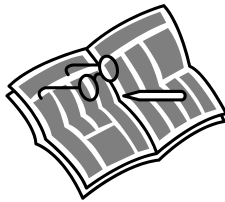


Tomorrow's Weather 84 F

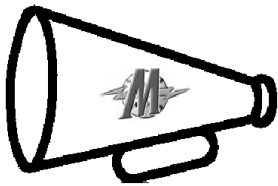

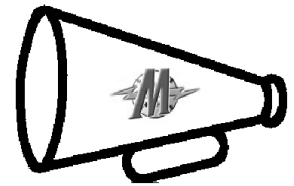
