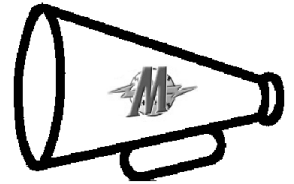

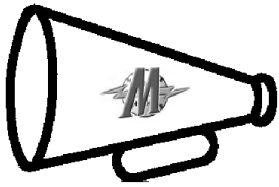


PLEASE can you all remember to use Sun screen. It is very important that you guys take care of your skin in this hot weather.

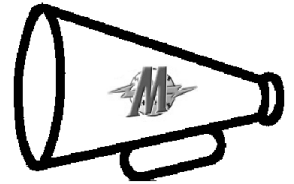
RANDOM FACT OF THE DAY
