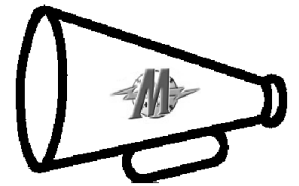

Menominee hit Minocqua by Editor

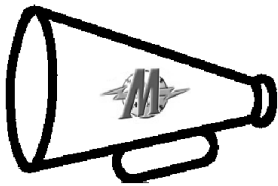

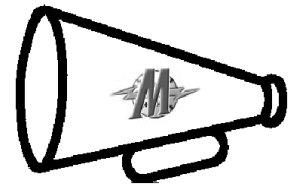
