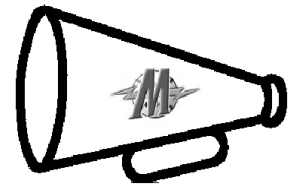

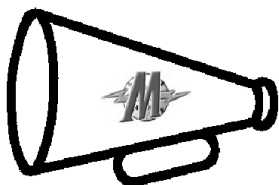

2014's Doc's Run Participants and their Finish Times

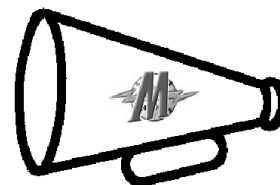
