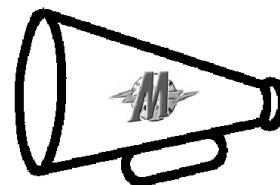

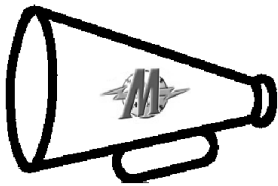
10:30am and it's the Last Day Brunch!

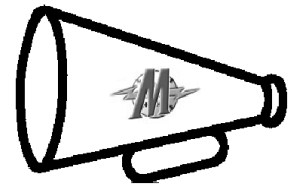
Last Day Banquet
