What a great day for a race! Cool, a few spots of rain, and over 140 participants (a record number). It took a lot of shuttles to get us all to the start (junction of O and 70, 4½ miles away), but by 7:36 we were ready. Pictures were taken, sweatshirts discarded, and bottles of water consumed, so, "On your marks, get set, Go!" **JON WOOL** hit the front straight away, and he was not to be seen again until he crossed the finish line in first place, a touch over 25 minutes later. That was an amazing time for an incredible runner. The next nine places were occupied by campers, including **CARTER DUNN** in second (31:11) and **REMY WEIMAN** in fourth (33:05). The first woman home this year was **MELANIE** (soon to be Mrs. Feldgreber) in 36:30. There were impressive times all over the place. Many people made huge improvements on their time from last year. **NATE SKRENTA-PIPKIN** (7th) was four minutes faster, as was **DYLAN GANGEL** (6th). Most impressive was counselor Miles Provus who was fully 23 minutes faster than his 2023 time. **JAYDEN PARKIN**, in only his third summer at CM, recorded a 44:54, a vast improvement on his 2023

time of 56:51. In 100th place (I stopped counting after this) was **STANLEY SIDER** in his first attempt at this distance. 73:35, for such a young camper (Cabin 3), was quite some feat. Snaps to everyone who took part, both here in the real-world and for those who took part elsewhere around the world.

A special thanks must go out to those sponsors, the **WELLEN** family, 3D Bakery (uncle of **REMY WEIMAN**), the **ACKERMAN** family, and the Frontiersman who helped us raise over \$25,000 to help send more kids to camp.

And, lest we forget: "the last place finisher will always beat the non-starter". Everyone who ran today completed the race, and all of us remember Dr. **KENNY MILLER**, after whom the race is named and dedicated.
