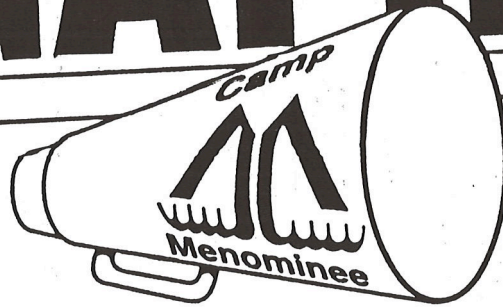

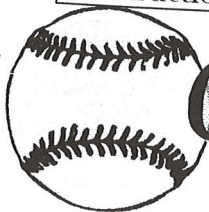

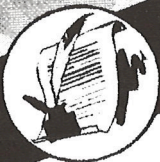
- Drink lots of water. Dehydration is the cause of lots of common complaints like headaches, nausea, and exhaustion.

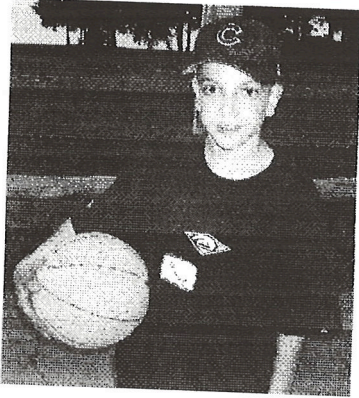

Hockey Eh?

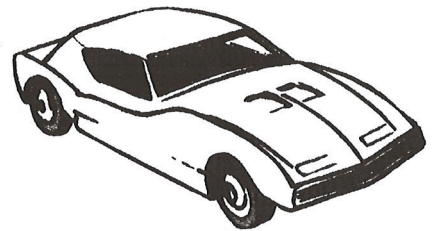

4TH GRADE "A" SHUTOUT

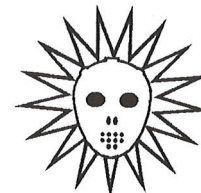

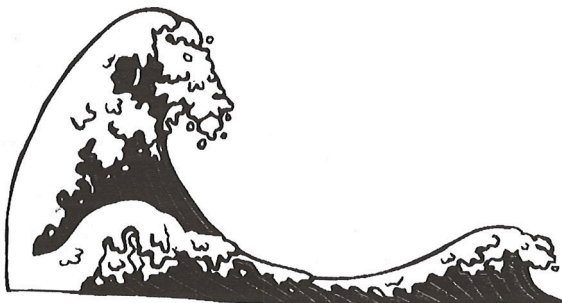
GOING TO THE WATER:

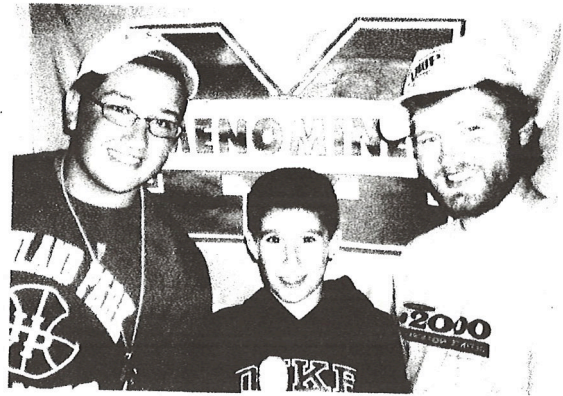

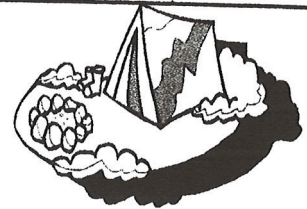

SENIORS BIG ADVENTURES! BY: THE SENIOR CABIN

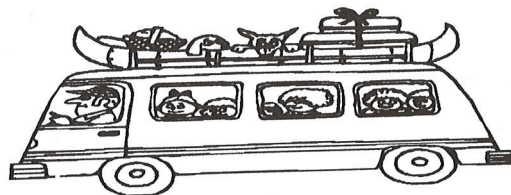

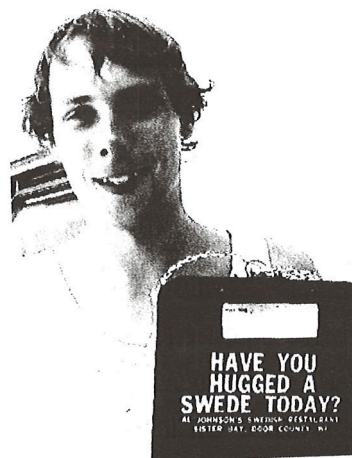

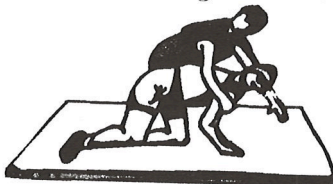
WATERFALL FUN FOR THE JUNIORS! By: Chris Henders

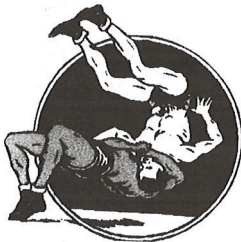

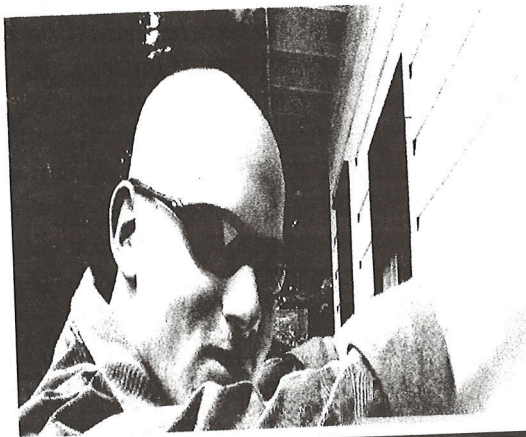
VOLLEYBALL AGAINST KAWAGA
